Tournament Rules and Information

Thank you for choosing Dragon's Fire Golf Club to host your golf tournament this season. Please observe the following standards of etiquette to foster an environment conducive to the enjoyment of the Club's facilities.

Dress Code

Participants must wear proper golf attire. Cargo pants, jeans, cut-offs, muscle shirts, track pants, tank tops, basketball shorts, or jerseys are not acceptable attire. All shirts must have collars and sleeves. Please ensure that you advise all participants that Dragon's Fire is a "soft spike" facility.

Participants - Each player must have their own set of clubs. Groups may not consist of more than four people.

Slow Play

The course is designed to be played within 4 ½ hours. We appreciate your cooperation in keeping pace with the group ahead for everyone's enjoyment.

Player Assistants

On course Assistants are there to help your group have a pleasant and enjoyable day. Please follow their directions.

Etiquette

Thank you for repairing ball marks, replacing divots and raking bunkers.

Convener

As the convener for the golf tournament, we appreciate your presence on the day of the tournament. Please arrive at Dragon's Fire Golf Club at least one hour prior to start of registration for your tournament.

Signage

Please deliver your signage to the course at least two hours prior to tee off to ensure enough time to place it on the proper holes. Dragon's Fire recommends that all outdoor signage be printed on corrugated plastic to accommodate all weather conditions.

Alcohol

Under our Liquor License Terms and Conditions, NO outside alcohol is permitted. Any players bringing their own alcohol, will have it confiscated and be requested to leave the premises without any refund. Dragon's Fire staff has the right to cut off an individual or group in order for us to serve responsibly and insure the safety of all our customers and employees. If an individual is cut off Dragon's Fire has zero tolerance for any violent behavior or offensive language. The Convener has read and agrees to abide by our alcohol policy.

GROUPINGS

We would appreciate receiving a list of all players and groupings a minimum of 72 hours in advance so the cart cards can be prepared.

Terms and Conditions

Booking

Your tournament is guaranteed when the contract is signed and a non-refundable deposit of 15% or \$1,500 (whichever is greater) is received by Dragon's Fire Golf Club.

Balance of Payment

The balance of the payment must be made the day of the event prior to the first tee off. An itemized receipt will be issued. Any necessary adjustments will be made within seven days.

Confirmed Numbers

A shotgun tournament involves a course closure for up to 144 golfers. For a shotgun event a reduction in the number of golfers within seven days of the tournament will not result in a reduction in price. The number of participants for the meal can be changed 10 days prior to the event. The balance owing for the meal portion shall be for the number of confirmed players and meals or the actual number the day of, whichever is greater. For non shotgun events, the number of golfers can be modified by up to 15% within 7 days of the scheduled event by written notification to Dragon's Fire. If you have contracted for a shotgun event and find that you cannot fill it, you must notify the golf club a minimum of 7 days in advance so that the shotgun can be changed to a split tees or straight tees event. If no such notification is received, you will be charged for the entire contracted amount regardless of the number of golfers that participate.

Weather

All tournaments will be deemed playable unless the course is closed by the superintendent. In the event of a course closure, we shall try to accommodate the rescheduling of the golf portion of the tournament at a mutually agreeable date in the same calendar year. The meal portion of the tournament will proceed as contracted.

Food and Beverage

Dragon's Fire Golf Club or their designated caterer will be the sole provider of food and beverage items.

Responsibility

It is agreed upon by all parties to this contract that Dragon's Fire Golf Club shall not be liable in any manner whatsoever for any damages sustained by any party to the contract or by any other person, firm, or corporation.

1. The convener agrees to indemnify and save harmless Dragon's Fire Golf Club against any and all claims and expenses by any other person, firm, or corporation, attending the function for loss or damages sustained on or off the premises of Dragon's Fire Golf Club.
2. The convener assumes liability for all damages to any property caused by any participant while in attendance at Dragon's Fire Golf Club.
3. The convener has read and understands our alcohol policy attached hereto and agrees to the terms and conditions therein.
4. The Convener indemnifies Dragon's Fire Golf Club for being unable to perform the contracted services as a result of flood, fire, or force of nature.

- Finalize sponsor support

10 Days Prior

- Confirm number of golfers and types of meals to the course
- Confirm contests with course
- Confirm registration set up with the course
- Confirm deliveries to the course
- Confirm number of club rentals required

7 Days Prior

- Revise pairings
- Finalize on course arrangements

48 Hours Prior

- Finalize details with course management
- Fax or email pairings for tournament play
- Deliver all course signs and materials

Less than 24 Hours Prior

- Arrive early to coordinate set up with course
- Decorate facility
- Set up registration and prize tables
- Coordinate volunteers
- Decorate banquet room
- Pay remaining balance of golf fees

After the Tournament

- Reconcile invoices
- Finalize budget
- Send thank-you replies to participants
- Update your website with tournament results
- Rebook tournament

Driving Directions

From Toronto South: Gardiner/ QEW Westbound. Exit North onto Brant St. Continue north to Cedar Springs Rd. West (left) onto Britannia Rd. North (right) onto Milborough Rd. Follow the road past the railroad tracks to the course on the left.

From Toronto North: 401 Westbound to 403 Westbound to 407 Westbound. Exit Dundas Street Westbound (right) North (right) on Cedar Springs Rd. West (Left) onto Britannia Rd. North (right) onto Milborough Rd. Follow the road past the railroad tracks to the course on the left.

From Niagara: QEW Westbound to Hwy 403 West Hamilton/Brantford. Exit North on Hwy 6 towards Guelph. Exit right (east) on Concession 8 East. Drive past the stop sign at Centre Road to the course on the right.

From Guelph: Hanlon Pkwy/Hwy 6 South. Merge onto Hwy 401 Eastbound. Exit South on Hwy 6 towards Hamilton at exit 299. Exit left (East) on Concession 8 East. Drive past the stop sign at Centre Road to the course on the right.
